

A Regular meeting of the Village Board of Tannersville was held on January 2nd, 1990 at the Village Hall in Tannersville at 8:00 P.M.

Mayor Rubinger explained that the monthly meeting was postponed last Tuesday due to the passing of the Village Clerks mother.

Motion by Trustee Powell that the minutes be approved as read.

Trustee Reich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Powell that the "sign permit" received from Kathleen Crawford be approved but stipulating that if DOT requests its removal during construction, sign would have to be removed.

Trustee Reich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Trustee Powell has reviewed all bids that were received for the 1989 or 1990 Four Wheel Drive, and having checked State bid prices feels the bids were too high.

Trustee Reich asked Attorney Lubow how they were coming on the selection for the Planning and Zoning Commissioners.

Attorney Lubow explained that he will get in touch with Mr. Roth and set up a meeting.

The commission will include the three board members, Loren Kashman, Mark HYer and Attorney Lubow.

No Building Permits were received this month.

Mayor Rubinger asked Trustee Powell if he would get some written proposals from various computer companies for our next meeting.

The Village Board is interested in setting up computers at the Clerks office.

Motion by Mayor Rubinger Deputy Clerk get all necessary papers and cards for signatures from the bank and have Clerk, Deputy Clerk and Mayor sign and return to the bank
