

A Regular meeting of the Village Board of Tannersville was held on July 24, 1990 at the Village Hall in Tannersville at 8:00 P.M.

Acting Mayor Stolz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Trustee Reich minutes be approved.

Acting Mayor Stolz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A request for a Peddler's Permit to sell ice cream at the Village lake raised some questions since the Greene County Youth Agency already has a concession there. Attorney Lubow suggested the permit exclude the lake property except when the boathouse is not open.

Motion by Trustee Reich they approve the permit with the stipulation that they "can not be operating when the boathouse is open".

Acting Mayor Stolz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mrs. Drao showed the "revised plans" for the McManus property. Mr. McManus intends to delete the ramp in front of his building which would result in more sidewalk space.

Trustee Reich asked Mrs. Drao to take the new plans to the building inspector for review and approval - Village board will accept the building inspectors approval.

An engineers report was received from the Meadowbrook Equities Sub-Division which was initially approved in 1983 inquiring if it were grandfathered from any new planning restrictions. This information to be reviewed at the next scheduled Planning Board meeting which will be held August 14, 1990.

Attorney Lubow raised the issue of the "junk car ordinance".

Board set a Public Hearing to be held on August 28, 1990 at 7:30 P.M.

Charles Valk reported that the sewer work is progressing as scheduled. currently house connections from the sewer main are being made while the overpaving of the streets will be done by a contractor.

Attorney Lubow requested two checks in the amount of \$25.00 each for the two deeds which have to be recorded at the County clerks office for the NYC Water Resources.

Motion by Trustee Reich we accept the request for the two deeds and Clerk to draw checks - to be given to Attorney Lubow to complete transaction.

Acting Mayor Stolz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Attorney Lubow brought up the continuing problem the village faces particulary on weekends at the A & P parking lot. He stated that there was a traffic jam on Main Street on Saturday and no police officer to handle the traffic.

Chief Nieves had stated at our previous meeting they would provide an officer on weekends to direct traffic and that if no one was there to give him a call. The chief further stated that he would have someone from the police dept. at our meetings, there was no one present nor a monthly report for this meeting.
