The Mayor opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.


The purpose of the meeting was to review the proposed 2003/2004 budget.




There being no further business, Trustee Morra made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mayor Weyant seconded. All in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
