Jill Dodds, Clerk



The Mayor opened the Hearing with the Pledge of Allegiance.


The Mayor read the resolution authorizing the execution of the stipulation of settlement in connection with the law suit between the City of New York and the Village of Tannersville over the Bike Path.

Trustee Morra made a motion to adopt the resolution. Trustee Legg seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.


