**Resolution # 2 of the Year 2004**

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE ARCHIVES LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECORDS MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT THE E-GOVERNMENT DISTRIBUTION OF FOILABLE RECORDS ON THE MUNICIPAL WEBSITE

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tannersville has engaged the services of Jonathan Ment and the Ment Media Group to prepare a funding application to assist the development of electronically posting FOILABLE municipal records (i.e. minutes, resolutions, local laws, election results, etc.) on the municipal website [www.tannersvilleny.org](http://www.tannersvilleny.org); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, Glenn Weyant, has requested authorization to file such application to the New York State Archives Local Government Management Improvement Fund (LGRMIF) and request the sum of \$3,634.00, three thousand, six hundred thirty four dollars and zero cents, in funding;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Glenn Weyant, as the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, is hereby authorized and directed to file an application for funds to the New York State Archives LGRMIF and upon awarding of grant funds request to enter into and execute a project agreement with the New York State Archives for such financial assistance to the Village of Tannersville.
