**VILLAGE OF TANNERSVILLE**

**RESOLUTION # 8 OF THE YEAR 2002**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tannersville desires to roll over a Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$246,814.08 to pay for the repair of reservoir #1, completing the multi-use bike path and paying for the snow plow; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tannersville, as a municipality, is tax exempt;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville borrow from Key Bank of New York, upon the faith and credit of the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville the sum of TWO HUNDRED, FORTY-SIX THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED, FOURTEEN AND EIGHT CENTS (\$246,814.08);

**RESOLVED**, that such loan shall be evidenced by a Bond Anticipation Note to mature on the 21st day of February 2003, subject to redemption prior to maturity on five day's notice, and bear interest at the rate of Two and Forty-Five Hundredths (2.45%) per centum per annum; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville execute and deliver for, in the name of, and on behalf of the Village Board of Tannersville said Bond Anticipation Note payable to Key Bank of New York, at its office in the Town of Hunter, New York, and shall have such other provisions and be in the form as may be approved by the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, his approval to be shown by his execution of the Bond Anticipation Note; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.


