

Resolution Number 28 of the year 2005

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville and the Town Board of the Town of Hunter has heretofore received a petition duly executed by at least twenty percent of the owners of a certain parcel of real property, approximately 1.5 acres in size located off Route 23A bearing the tax map number of 165.20-2-10, seeking the annexation thereof into the Village of Tannersville; and

WHEREAS, such annexation had been completed in accordance with the requirements of Article 7 of the General Municipal Law and such parcel is now within the geographic confines of the Village of Tannersville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to take whatever steps necessary to obtain approval from the NYCDEP to allow the Catskill Mountain Housing Development Corporation a sewer connection in accordance with the 1924 Agreement between the Village of Tannersville, the Town of Hunter and the City of New York.


