

**VILLAGE OF TANNERSVILLE
RESOLUTION #6 OF 2005**

**AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A \$1,000 BOND FEE TO BE ADDED
TO THE VILLAGE HIGHWAY ROADWORK PERMIT**

WHEREAS, at times residents need permission to have work done across a village street (i.e.: water tap, sewer hook up, etc);

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville recommended to the Village board that the permit application be modified to include a \$1,000 bond fee for maintenance of the road or street without using village monies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Highway work permit application will be modified and updated to include a \$1,000 bond fee for the maintenance of a Village Road or Street that is torn up do to certain types of construction.
