RESOLUTION #10 OF THE YEAR 2002

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF SMALL CITIES FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG).

WHEREAS, in accordance with the goals of the USDA Department of Housing and Urban Development, the New York State Governor's Office of Small Cities is offering grant funds for eligible communities, and

WHEREAS, such grants are intended to enable municipalities to complete public facilities improvements to their communities that benefit persons of low and moderate income, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tannersville has engaged the services of J. Kenneth Fraser and Associates, PE, LS, LA P.C. to prepare a New York State Governor's Office of Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville has requested authorization to file such CDBG application to the NYS Governor's Office of Small Cities to provide funding for the 2002 Water System Improvements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Glenn Weyant, as Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, is hereby authorized and directed to file an application for funds from the NYS Governor's Office of Small Cities in accordance with the provisions of the USDA Department of Housing and Urban Development in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 and upon approval of said request to enter into and execute a project agreement with the NYS Governor's Office of Small Cities for such financial assistance to the Village of Tannersville, and be it further

RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
