

VILLAGE OF TANNERSVILLE
RESOLUTION #6 OF THE YEAR 2003

WHEREAS, the Village of Tannersville is the owner and operator of its own water supply system, and

WHEREAS, there are various community groups and organizations that are not for profit and are for civic, charitable, religious, educational and other community minded purposes, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned groups and/or organizations own buildings and facilities that at times are available to the community, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board would like to continue and encourage the owners of these facilities to continue to make their premises available to the public for meetings and/or events, by waiving any fees for water rents to the actual building that is made available or used as a community resource, provided that such building is not permanently used for commercial or residential purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Glenn Weyant and seconded by Paul Morra, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees held on the 20th day of February, 2003, it is therefore

RESOLVED, that the Village of Tannersville may, by resolution, exempt and waive water rents and fees of any not for profit community organization that owns a building that is served by the Tannersville Water Company, and permits (at times) the public or other community groups to use the building and/or facilities, provided that the resolution may be canceled or rescinded on thirty days notice, and it is further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
