AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) FOR THE ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the goals of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to ensure that firefighter safety and fire prevention programs are properly funded, and

WHEREAS, such funding will provide volunteer fire departments help with firefighter training and safety, public outreach and fire prevention efforts, emergency medical training and the purchase of firefighting equipment and vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville has requested authorization to file such Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program application to provide firefighting and safety equipment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Glenn Weyant, Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, is hereby authorized and directed to have the Tannersville Fire Department make such application in an amount of approximately \$33,000 and upon approval of said request to enter into and execute a project agreement with FEMA for such financial assistance to the Tannersville Fire Department, and further

BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution take effect immediately.
