On motion of Mayor Glenn Weyant, seconded by Trustee Daniel Powell, the following Resolution was adopted by the Board by unanimous vote.


WHEREAS, bond counsel informed the Village of Tannersville by letter dated December 12, 2001, that an Act of the State Legislature is necessary in regard to the outstanding bond anticipation note and revenue anticipation note,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board, through the Mayor, requests the State Legislature, through Assemblyman Faso, to pass legislation in accordance with the recommendations of Bond Counsel, Hawkins, Delafield & Wood, in the form of a draft Act in regard to the Village's outstanding bond anticipation note and revenue anticipation note.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution take effect immediately.
