


WHEREAS there are stormwater problems and pollution in the area of Park Lane and Spring Street in the Village of Tannersville, and


WHEREAS it is known that numerous sump pumps within the Village are connected to the sanitary sewer, resulting in impacts to treatment plant operations and water quality, and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees met with representatives of the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) and Kaaterskill Engineering Associates PC on August 24 to discuss these problems,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the engineering firm of Kaaterskill Engineering Associates PC at 24 Joel M. Austin Road, Cairo, New York is hereby authorized to submit applications for the Park Lane/Spring Street project and for the sump pump disconnection project for the CWC Stormwater Retrofits Program, which program provides 75% funding for the correction or reduction of existing erosion, polluted runoff and other problems associated with stormwater.
