RESOLUTION # 19 OF THE YEAR 2002

WHEREAS, the Village of Tannersville is desirous of making available to the general public the Village Meeting Hall and the Lake Pavilion/Boathouse as a place to conduct meetings and other events,

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Glenn Weyant, seconded by Paul Morra, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees, held on July, 2002,

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Village of Tannersville is hereby empowered to lease the Village Meeting Hall and kitchen area and Lake Pavilion and Boathouse to individuals or groups for functions and other meetings and events which do not interfere or conflict with the use of the premises by the Village or its municipal agencies, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Board shall have the right to and will publish at the Village Clerk's office a list of the fees to be charged and the rules and regulations to be imposed upon users, including any requirement of damage deposits and rental fees, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said rules and regulations may provide that any user fee be waived for any Village of Tannersville resident or organization, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
