**PROPOSED RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF
TANNERSVILLE VILLAGE BOARD AUTHORIZING OPPOSITION
TO THE DEC MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Environmental Conservation has presented a revised draft for the Master Plan for the Catskill Park and has held public meetings for review of this plan; and

WHEREAS, included in this Master Plan is a restriction of certain parcels of land that include trails within the Village of Tannersville that are used for recreational purposes. The restriction of this land will impose certain hardships and economic impacts on the Village of Tannersville as well as all of Greene County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville is opposed to the New York City Department of Environmental Conservation Master Plan that would change the current design of lands within the Catskill Forest Preserve; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville request that the New York City Department of Environmental Conservation not adopt the revised draft of the Master Plan.
