**RESOLUTION # 12 OF THE YEAR 2002**

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF PARKS, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE RIP VAN WINKLE LAKE PARK.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Tannersville is preparing an Economic Revitalization Strategy/Action Plan for the Village, and

**WHEREAS**, a goal of this plan is to develop and revitalize the Rip Van Winkle Lake and Park in support of the overall strategy to revitalize the local economy, and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the Village of Tannersville has requested authorization to file a grant application to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation to complete funding for Phase 1 of the Rip Van Winkle Park Improvement Project,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** Glenn Weyant, as Mayor of the Village of Tannersville, is hereby authorized and directed to file an application for funds from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation in accordance with the provisions of Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 or Title 3 of the Clean Water/Clean Air Bond Act of 1996, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000, and upon approval of said request to enter into and execute a project agreement with the State for such financial assistance to the Village of Tannersville, and


**BE IT RESOLVED** that this Resolution take effect immediately.
