WHEREAS the Village of Tannersville is applying to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (NYSOPRHP) for a grant under the 2002 TEA-21 Recreational Trails Program for a trail project to be located at Rip Van Winkle Park, located within the territorial jurisdiction of the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville; and

WHEREAS the Village of Tannersville will apply for a reimbursable funding grant not to exceed \$100,000 and understands that reimbursement of funds from NYSOPRHP will not exceed 80 per cent; and

WHEREAS the Village of Tannersville has retained the professional services of J. Kenneth Fraser and Associates, PE, LS, LA, P.C. to develop, write and submit the grant application; and

WHEREAS as a requirement under the rules of these programs, said not-for-profit corporation must obtain the approval of the governing body of the Village of Tannersville in which the project will be located;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this august body that the Village of Tannersville Board hereby does approve and endorse the submission of this grant application under the 2002 TEA-21 Recreational Trails Program for a trail development project within the boundaries of Rip Van Winkle Park; and be it further

RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
