**AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST OF ENACTMENT OF LEGISLATION BY
THE NEW YORK STATE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Tannersville had previously requested the enactment of legislation which would ratify, validate and confirm certain actions of the Village and authorize the issuance of obligations of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill S.3253-B and Assembly Bill A.7277-A have been introduced to accomplish said purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, Village officials and Counsel have reviewed such pieces of legislation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Tannersville, acting by and through its Village Board, does hereby request the enactment of Senate Bill S.3253-B and Assembly Bill A.7277-A, introduced as part of the 2004 session of the New York State Legislature,

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
