WHEREAS, the State of New York Department of Transportation requires the actual approval, consent and authorization from the Village Board to proceed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee, to enter into any and all contracts, easements or other agreements with the DEC, DOT or other state agency and any residents to complete the Sump Pump Rehabilitation Project in the Village of Tannersville and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville agrees to maintain the sump pump system during its period of usefulness and effectiveness, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville hereby agrees to hold the State of New York harmless for any damages arising out of claims for damages for to property of for personal injury resulting from the construction and operation of the system and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville shall be responsible for ensuring that only non-chlorinated water shall be introduced into the system.
