WHEREAS: The Village of Tannersville has previously created the office of Village attorney

WHEREAS: the office of Village attorney has certain defined duties which need to be defined;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Trustee Daniel Powell, seconded by Trustee Paul Morra, at a regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees held on the 20th day of December, 2001, it is therefore

RESOLVED, that the Village of Tannersville position of Village attorney is continued at an annual salary of five thousand (\$5,000) dollars per year;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village attorney be required to attend the Village Court of Tannersville, New York, on at least one occasion per month for the purpose of prosecuting violations of Village local laws, ordinances or such other laws as is authorized by any other law of the State of New York.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
