At a regular meeting of the Village Board held on November 6, 2000 at 8:00 p.m. In the Village Hall, the following Village officers being present.

Trustee Morra offered the following Resolution:

WHEREAS water consumers have been shutting off their water at the beginning of a six month billing period and requesting relief from that period's water charge, and

WHEREAS some consumers reconnect before the end of the six month period without informing the Village, and

WHEREAS the splitting of the original yearly billing into two six month bills was made solely to ease the financial burden on consumers, and


WHEREAS the water charges are based on the Water Board's yearly expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that consumers desiring to discontinue the use of the water, wholly or in part on account of vacancy of the premises, must give due notice to the Water Commissioners in writing of such vacancy, but no adjustment will be allowed and the owner will be held responsible for such water rent at the full amount.
